Did you know...

- There can be as many as 49 million cases of influenza each year in the US
- And as many as 960,000 may require hospitalization, including up to 48,000 infants
- Causing anywhere from 12,000 to 70,000 deaths

Infants and seniors are most at risk

Children ages 5 to 19 and adults ages 30-39 are the biggest source of spread during flu season
